1. Organization providing the training:

3. Description of the training offered:

Certified Clinical Medical Assisting – 340 hours, 100 hour unpaid externship in a medical practice

- Major Components: Medical terminology, vital signs and other physical measurements, infection control procedures, chain and state of infection, laboratory procedures and functions including OSHA reduction and Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments standards.
- After successful completion of the training, participants are eligible to sit for the certification examination given by the National Healthcare Association to become a Certified Clinical Medical Assistant.

Dental Assisting & Radiology – 118 hours

- Major Components: Dental anatomy, terminology, instruments and infection control procedures, making impressions, passing instruments, and taking dental x-rays
- Training includes instruction in dental assisting and radiology and access to an open lab to practice hands-on skills.
- After successful completion of the training, participants are prepared to take the Dental Assisting National Board (DANB) Radiology and Health Safety (RHS) exam.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized credentials:

Dental Assisting National Board Radiology and Health and Safety Exam Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) – National Healthcare Association

5. Am I eligible?

To be eligible you must:

- Be an Anne Arundel County Resident.
- Be 18 years or older.
- Be eligible to work in the United States.
