Become a Certified Peer Recovery Coach through Catholic Charities of Baltimore and get on the path to a great career through this Maryland Addiction and Behavioral-health Professionals Certification Board (MABPCB) approved training. The program includes two weeks of classroom instruction, case management, one week of career readiness, optional digital literacy training, and job placement.

Peer recovery coaches require lived experience with substance use disorder, are in sustained sobriety and have a drive to help others.
