3. Description of the training offered:

This program prepares the students to earn the Light Vehicle Repair Certification through the National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence. In addition to light vehicle repair, students earn three additional certifications on electrical systems, brake system and suspension and steering. The training is in person, utilizing state of the art simulators, classes are typically held two nights a week (three hours a night), over the course of 25 weeks.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized credentials:

Four ASE certifications:

- Light vehicle repair
- Electrical systems
- Brake systems
- Suspension and steering.

5. Am I eligible?

To be eligible participants must be:

- 16 years or older.
- Have a valid driver's license.
- Able to read, speak, write, and understand English.
