1. Organization providing the training:

Dwyer Workforce Development and It Works Learning Center, Inc.

2. Physical location where training occurs:

Classes are held online and in-person, skills and clinicals are held in person at various approved clinical locations.

3. Description of the training offered:

The CNA/GNA training program is a 140 hour certificate program that provides students with the training and clinical experience necessary to obtain both their CNA and GNA licenses. The CNA/GNA program is broken into two components: (1) 100 hours of classroom instruction and (2) 40 hours of clinical training. Depending on the class, the classroom instruction is either taught online or in person; however, all clinical rotations are taught in person.
