This innovative five-week electrical apprenticeship training opportunity aims to cultivate future electrical journeymen while fostering broader career insights within related trades. The training includes CPR, first aid, and general safety training as well as an overview of the electrical industry. Individuals will also learn basic math and complete skills reviews while participating in hands-on experience on job sites. This comprehensive program entails a rigorous schedule, consisting of in-classroom learning three days a week Monday-Wednesday from 8AM to 12PM. Along with on-the-job training Thursday-Friday for eight hours each day. The combination totals 60 hours of in class instruction and 80 hours of paid time learning on the job.

**4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized credentials:**

CPR and First Aid Certifications.

**5. Am I eligible?**

Applicants must be 17-22 years old. Access to reliable transportation is a plus.
