1. Organization providing the training:

2. Physical location where training occurs:

District Heights, MD

3. Description of the training offered:

The courses include general knowledge and review of federal motor carriers' safety regulations, vehicle inspection procedures, air brakes, and defensive driving techniques. There will be 140 hours of theory and 160 hours of practical (on-the road) training.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized credentials:

- Commercial Driver's License Class A
- Commercial Driver's License Class B

5. Am I eligible?

To be eligible, an applicant must be eligible to work in the United States, reside in Prince George's County Maryland, and be either unemployed or underemployed.

6. What is the application process?

To apply, register at pgcareers.com. You will be asked to upload required documents and then meet with an Employ Prince George's Intake Specialist.

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment in the transportation and logistics field?

The average starting wages in Prince George's County are:

CDL-A: \$29.50 per hour

CDL-B: \$23.25 per hour
