3. Description of the training offered:

Jordan Peer Recovery's Community Health Worker (CHW) training program totals 152 hours and is designed to equip individuals with the essential skills and knowledge to effectively support and promote community health. The program integrates theoretical learning, practical skills development, and supervised fieldwork to ensure trainees are well-prepared for their roles. The foundational knowledge segment introduces trainees to the role of a CHW, via the nine principles of public health adopted by the Maryland Department of Health, and the importance of social determinants of health. This segment also covers ethical standards, professional boundaries, and the significance of cultural responsiveness in community health work.

5. Am I eligible?

To be eligible participants must be 18 years of age or older and obtain a high school diploma/GED®.
