- Certified Peer Recovery Specialist (CPRS)
- Integrated Forensic Peer Recovery Specialist (iFPRS)
- Certified Peer Recovery Specialist-Family (CPRS-F)

5. Am I eligible?

To be eligible participants must be 18 years of age or older, obtain a high school diploma/GED®, and have lived experience (direct or indirect) with recovery.
