### 3. Description of the training offered:

Raising the Bar is a six-week, in-person MC3 pre-apprenticeship program offered four times annually - twice in Baltimore and twice in Prince George's County. Participants gain hands-on experience and earn three industry-recognized certifications: the MC3 Certificate, OSHA 10, and First Aid/CPR/AED.

The curriculum covers key topics essential to career readiness in the union construction industry, including construction math, basic blueprint reading, green construction practices, and equal employment opportunity principles.

# 4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

- MC3 Certificate
- OSHA 10
- First Aid, CPR, and AED





### 5. Am I eligible?

You are eligible for the program if you:

- Are 18 years or older
- Possess a Valid Driver's License
- Have passed a drug test
- Are willing to sit for a math test
- Are willing to interview for enrollment

#### 6. What is the application process?

Fill out the <u>Google form</u> to attend an info session

- At the info session, sign up to take the math test
- After the math test you will take a drug test
- You will be invited for an interview once drug test results have been reviewed

# 7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment?

Participants in the program may receive wages ranging from \$20-\$23/hour.
