BACKGROUND

INFORMATION: WIFI No. 10-10 included the PY 2011 and FY 2012 local WIA formula allocations.

The PY 2011 calculations were based on 5% Statewide Set-Aside funds.

The FY 2012 calculations were based on 15% Statewide Set-Aside funds, pending final guidance from DOL regarding the calculation of the FY 2012 Statewide Set-Aside funds.

TEGL 9-11 clarified that the FY 2012 Statewide Set-Aside funds are 5% of the State

Allotment.

TEGL 9-11 also included a 1.503% rescission of the FY 2012 Adult and Dislocated Worker State Allotment, due to the Short-Term Continuing Appropriations Acts, 2012.

The decrease of Adult funding is -\$132,611.

The decrease of Dislocated Worker funding is -\$173,840.

The local FY 2012 Adult and Dislocated Worker allocations were revised to reflect

these changes.

The revised FY 2012 allocations are listed below.

Up to 10% of the allocation can be used for administrative expenditures.
