Ref: Clarifying the Design and Inspection Responsibility of Manufacturer-Supplied Items Indicated  
on Construction documents

The manufacturer of any industrialized building and its Approved Testing Facility (ATF) should be held responsible for the design of all items indicated as manufacturer-supplied on construction documents, unless explicitly noted on plans otherwise.

In addition, the same manufacturer and its Approved Testing Facility (ATF) are held responsible for the proper installation and inspection of these manufacturer-supplied items after they have been installed on site unless explicitly noted on plans otherwise.
